# A Holy Life - 1 Peter 1:10-2:3

With the firm hope of the gospel of grace freshly explained in chapter 1, Peter goes on in the next section of his letter to challenge his audience into active and willing obedience to God. We have listed in our reading a set of imperatives (or commands) to act in a certain way. 1:13, "...set your hope...". V14, "...do not conform...". V15, "...be holy...". V17, "...live out...". V22 "...love one another...". 2:1, "...rid yourselves...". And v2 "...crave pure spiritual milk...". The obvious conclusion is, if you have understood the wonderful mercy of God and the great hope of the resurrection, then your lives can not remain the same. Verse 23 puts it succinctly. "For you have been born again, not of perishable seed, but of imperishable, through the living and enduring word of God." If we notice that our desire to live a holy life is absent, we can be certain we have misunderstood the gospel.
