

Galatians 2:11-21 – Justification by Faith Alone

Today's passage at the end of Galatians 2 gives us a most extraordinary insight into the early church, and into the genuineness of the Christian faith. When you think about it, if someone was to invent a religion, or create some new belief system to transform the world, then Galatians 2:11-21 would definitely NOT be included in its founding documents. And yet this almost embarrassing historical incident is recorded for us centering on the foundational principles of the Christian faith. Our passage describes the moment, and the reason, for a conflict between the two greatest Apostles. Central to this conflict was the necessity of Jesus' death for us, and the means by which we receive this amazing gift. It is only by faith in Christ alone that we are justified before God, and receive the benefits of his sacrificial death.
