

Galatians 5:1-15 – Freedom in Christ

One of the great reminders in Paul's letter to the Galatians is that, as Christians we have been set free from obedience to the Law of Moses, and have been saved through faith in the completed work of our Lord Jesus Christ. As we have been reading this letter together we have been warned not to return to the old religion of 'do' (do this, and don't do that), but rather we are to enjoy the freedom of what Jesus has already 'done' for us on the cross. However, Paul does not stop his letter there. In fact, in Galatians 5:13 Paul goes on to say, "You, my brothers and sisters, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the flesh; rather, serve one another humbly in love." Christian freedom does not mean that we are free to live however we choose. Rather, Christians enjoy freedom from the guilt of sin, and are now free to lovingly serve one another in response.
