The Strength of Humility – 1 Peter 5:1-14

For the Apostle Peter it must have been extremely humbling to be rebuked and corrected by his teacher, Jesus. Even after Peter had denied knowing Jesus before his death we know that he was deeply effected and wept bitterly (Luke 22:62), and what is more Peter's mistakes were carefully recorded and made available for everyone to read! But, in one of the most extraordinary acts in the gospels, Jesus graciously restores Peter fully and calls on him to care for the new emerging church (John 21:15-17). And as a direct result of Jesus' command we have this first letter of Peter's to read and to learn from. At the heart of Peter's exhortation, to be willing to suffer for obeying and following Jesus, is humility. In verse 6 he says, "Humble yourselves, therefore, under God's mighty hand, that he may lift you up in due time." You see, through suffering comes glory.

And those who would humble themselves and follow Jesus, whatever the cost, will share in Christ's eternal glory. This is the strength of humility.

SCRIPTURE UNION BOYS' CAMP:

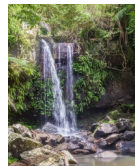
