

Galatians 3:1-14 – The Folly of the Galatians

Galatians 1 and 2 have been a clear explanation by the Apostle Paul of the central truth of Christianity, that people are put into right relationships with God as they trust in Jesus' death for their sin. When we think we can be saved by doing good things to please God, we have completely missed the point and '...nullified the death of Christ' (2:21). It is no wonder that Paul uses such strong language when addressing the Galatians. In fact, the J.B. Phillips translation of Galatians 3:1 begins, "Dear idiots,..."!! Those who have been taught and shown the basics of the Christian faith are blindly wondering away from God and leading others into this false teaching. And so Paul wants to arrest their slide away from God, and he wants to remind them of why the gospel is actually good news. Let us take heed of Paul's warning, lest we be idiots!
