

Galatians 5:16-26 – Life by the Spirit

There are many conflicts that we pray about. Wars in regions around the world, misunderstandings between disagreeing friends, tensions within our own families. But the last half of Galatians 5 reminds us of an even greater conflict that occurs within every Christian. This conflict is between the desires of the flesh, (or some Bibles say 'the sinful nature') and the work of God's Spirit. These warring parts of the Christian life play a significant role in the daily lives of those who have found freedom in Christ. As Paul has said in the previous paragraph (v13), the Christian is not to use their freedom as a license to indulge the flesh. Rather we are called to put to death the passions and desires of the flesh (which are defined in our passage), and we are called to live by the Spirit. So, may we be encouraged to pray daily for the conflict within.
