

Galatians 4:8-31 – Paul's concern for the Galatians

Once again, in addressing the Galatian heresy, Paul brings us an illustration from the Old Testament, in Galatians 4:21-31. He refers to the horrible situation back in Genesis 16 and 21, when Abraham thought he would start his own nation outside the promises of God. Both he and Sarah thought they were doing the right thing by starting a family with Hagar, the servant girl. But ultimately they ran ahead of God and His perfect plan. Their mistake now serves as an example and illustration for us. Those who are born as children under law, will be slaves to the law. Those who are born again as children of the promise, will inherit the precious promises given to Abraham. So then, we are not to go back to living under the curse of the law, but rather Christ has set us free, so we can now live as children of the promise.
